Hello Bulldog Families,

I wanted to take this opportunity to send you information about food distribution from our schools for the time period from March 31, 2020 to April 7, 2020. At this time, we are scheduled, per Governor Pritzker, to return to school on April 8, 2020, but that date is subject to change upon review by our governor.

We will follow the same procedure we've been following for this past week for food distribution:

- Pickup time: 10:00 a.m. - noon
- Pickup sites: Lincoln Trail Elementary and Middletown Prairie Elementary
- We will also deliver food to your home if you need that service.
- You will get breakfast and lunch for each child.

As a reminder, any child under the age of 18 is eligible for these meals.
