Students may sign up for more than 1 camp during the different weeks if the camps are offered for their grade level.

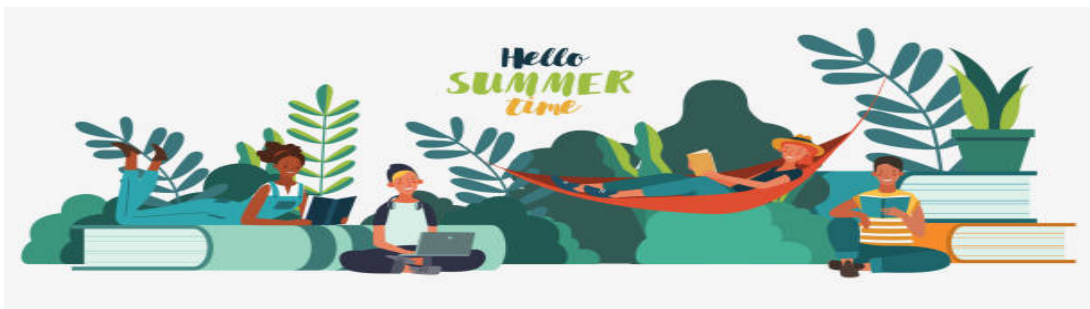


