

Ninnekah Public School - Learning Plan Quick Facts

OVERVIEW

Ninnekah Public School is committed to maintaining stability during the school closure and will be providing students with instruction until the end of the school year.

EXPECTATIONS

Students are expected to complete all work assigned. Depending on your student's grade level, assignments will be offered online or in packet/worksheet form.

If your child does not have internet access at home or a device to work on assignments online, a packet/worksheet will be provided.

HOW TO PICK UP WORK

Students may pick up their work beginning April 6. Those who are participating in the cafeteria grab and go lunch program may pick up a homework packets at that time. More information will be provided from each building regarding specific details and/or other pick-up schedules.

HOW TO COMMUNICATE

Teachers will be available by e-mail, text, Facebook messenger, communication apps (Remind, Group Me, etc.), and occasionally by school phone.

HOW DO I GET MY PERSONAL BELONGINGS FROM THE SCHOOL

Each site will have a staggered, assigned time for students to retrieve belongings from their lockers.

Students in possession of items that belong to the school such as library books, textbooks, or sports uniforms should return them when they pick up their personal belongings.

MEAL OPTIONS

We will continue to provide meals on a grab and go basis from 10 am – 1 pm Monday – Friday. Delivery for those unable to pick will be available.

MAJOR EVENTS

All end of the year events are postponed at this time. The school will make decisions about rescheduling these events based on state and CDC guidelines.
