Artwork Updates:

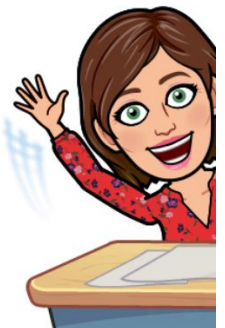
