SAT/ACT Updates/Registration- Please make sure that you are getting all of your updated information from reliable sites. Below are the two official sites for the Collegeboard (SAT/AP Exams) and ACT Exam. Currently, the SAT will still be offered on the first weekend of June. The May test date has been canceled. The ACT April 4th test date has been canceled but you may register for the June 13th date.

SAT/ACT Exam Fee Waiver Information- If you did not take the SAT School Day Exam at your school and need a fee waiver, please contact your Career Center Specialist or College and Career Counselor to see if you qualify. If you did take the SAT School Day Exam and have been cleared in the CollegeBoard system then you can automatically sign up for two additional SAT Exams and up to 6 SAT Subject Tests for free.

SAT School Day Score Information- If you took the SAT School Day Exam at your school on March 4th your scores are available online through [CollegeBoard](#).

SAT/ACT Prep Information- Free SAT/ACT preparation is available on [Khan Academy](#). If you have previously taken a PSAT Exam you can link your scores to your Khan Academy account and get specialized practice tailored to your needs.

College Tours-Virtual Tours of Campuses- Many students choose to start visiting college campuses during their sophomore and junior years of high school. Please don't let our current situation deter you from beginning your college search. You can go to many university websites and take virtual tours of campus and housing facilities.

Cal Grant GPA Explanation- The Cal Grant is a form of financial aid that helps students cover the cost of tuition and fees. It is based on your family's income as well as your performance in high school. Your grades matter and can equal a higher amount of money you qualify for once senior year comes. It is important to stay strong academically during these times. Your Cal Grant eligibility is calculated based upon your 10th and 11th grade academic GPA. Your goal is to achieve a 3.0 Cal Grant GPA.
