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PURPOSE

- The purpose of this guide is to provide answers and expectations during our time of continuous learning.
- Our goal is to provide lessons, activities, and support to students so they can practice skills they have learned throughout the year.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students will be asked to complete all assignments given by their teachers.
- Students should find a workspace that is distraction-free and has space for necessary items to complete assignments.
- Students will reach out to their teacher via email if they need help
- Student will be patient with yourself and your teachers -- we are all learning together!



INSTRUCTION

- OMS students are familiar with how their teacher delivers digital content.
- Parents/students will also be able to locate links to each teacher/subject through the OMS Website page.
- Students will receive at least 1 lesson each week from their teachers.
- We encourage you to work ahead in a class if you would like.
- Students should communicate to their teachers their desire to work ahead. Teachers will be more than happy to assign enrichment opportunities!

HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH MY CHILD'S TEACHER(S)

- Starting April 6th, teachers will be working from home to assist your child -- they can be reached via email by using the following format (first_last@oologab.k12.ok.us).
- Teachers will be available to conference between 8:00am-3:00pm.
- Teachers will not be available in the evenings or on weekends.
- Teachers will respond to any questions you have within 24 hours.
- Teachers' emails can also be found on the OMS Website page.
- Teachers will be communicating with students at least once a week via Remind, Spark, Google Classroom, or email (Outlook).



ASSIGNMENT SUBMISSION

- Work is to be submitted online. Please ensure that you are meeting your teacher's due dates for assignments.
- Assignments/projects will not physically be returned to teachers.

GRADING PRACTICES

- Points will be given for assignments completed and submitted digitally.
- Assignments given during this time can only improve your child's overall class grade.

MEAL OPTIONS

- Grab & Go Meals will be served weekdays through the end of the school year.
- Meals can be picked up by using a drive thru service in front of the Upper Elementary between 9:00am-11:00am.
- Breakfast and lunch will be distributed at the same time.
- Meals are offered to any child under the age of 18.
- The child must be present in the vehicle to receive a Grab & Go Meal.
