

# Arkansas AMI Instruction Beginning April 6

## For Elementary K-4 grades:

The Arkansas Department of Education has worked with Arkansas PBS to provide Arkansas AMI educational programming and coordinating lessons. Beginning Monday, April 6, all El Dorado students in grades K-8 will use Arkansas AMI to continue learning while schools are closed due to COVID-19.

Elementary students will watch the videos **each day** on your local PBS channel or at <https://www.myarkansaspbs.org/ArkansasAMI> (once there, choose your grade level: K-2 or 3-5).

There is also an app where you can access these videos and learning guides. You can download the Engage Arkansas PBS app for free use on iPads, Chromebooks, or smartphones.



A new Learning Guide will be posted each week that will list activities in core subject areas that coordinate with the PBS shows. We will begin with **week 2 Learning Guide on April 6.**

Through Google Classroom, teachers will assign students specific activities from the Learning Guide as their weekly Essential Learning Activities. Students will be required to complete one writing, one reading, one math and one science activity each week. Students can then use the Learning Guide to choose any other activities that they want to do.

For those without Internet access, a paper copy of the Learning Guides will be available at the school offices. The specific Essential Learning Activities for each grade level will be posted on a cover sheet of the paper copy.

Each elementary teacher is setting up a Google Classroom for their class and will be contacting parents with the information on joining the class. For detailed instructions on using Google Classroom, click on the AMI link at [www.eldoradopublicschools.org](http://www.eldoradopublicschools.org).

Students can turn in their work by uploading it to Google Classroom or turning in paper copies to your school. A box designated for student work will be located outside of the entrance of each school.
