Noble High School- Continuous Learning Plan

Noble High School will offer a continuous learning structure that will be a combination of existing Canvas LMS Coursework, Google Classroom, Content Specific Apps, and packet-based modules. Teachers will have 2 hours of availability each day for students who need assistance or guidance. Coursework packets will be available for pickup at Noble Public Schools Central Office for any students that may have connectivity or technology concerns, beginning on April 6, 2020. <https://nobleps.instructure.com/>

For teacher support, Noble High School will be offering a five (5) week course in Canvas, with the end goal being content development for the 2020-2021 school year. Teachers will move through 3 tiers of virtual training to include basic technology skills, Canvas Essentials, and Advanced Applications.

In addition, each teacher will have a selected number of students in a virtual homeroom. These homerooms will serve as a pathway for communication with families and students. The focus of the homerooms is to assess the digital learning delivery needed for each student as well as a determination of what additional services a student may need (Food, Water, Mental Health, etc.).

Virtual department meetings will take place on Mondays and Thursdays. These meetings are designed to monitor and adjust instruction as needed. In addition, we will provide technical assistance each day for those teachers needing extra support, from 1-4 pm. Our end goal is to provide a quality continuation of learning and provide the training necessary to operate on a single platform (Canvas) in the fall of 2020. Administrative support will also be available each day.

Expected Student Participation Time: No more than 30 minutes per subject, maximum of 3 hours per day. Our goal is to support and enrich the academic development of our students.
