<b>Online Instruction: Monitor and Respond</b>	To monitor Online Instruction and make plans for further support, it is important to review Student Lesson Alerts, Time-on-Task, and Percent of Lessons Passed. Each of these components can help you determine how much progress students are making. Use this <a href="#">Online Instruction Action Plan Worksheet</a> to monitor and respond.
<b>Online Instruction: Student Lesson Logs</b>	Students can use Online Instruction Lesson Logs to track their progress through <i>i-Ready</i> lessons and capture learnings as well as questions. Use one or more of the <a href="#">Online Instruction Lesson Logs</a> to increase student engagement and encourage students to track their progress.
<b>Engage Students: Track Data*</b>	Engage students in their learning by having them track online lesson progress. Use <a href="#">these trackers</a> to hold students accountable during <i>i-Ready</i> time and create an artifact of learning.
