



Military Recruitment List “Opt-Out” Form

The Every Student Succeeds Act of 2015 (ESSA) requires school districts to release the names, addresses, and telephone listings (including unlisted numbers) of secondary school students to military recruiters upon their request unless the parent/legal guardian of a student or an eligible student (18 years or older) requests that the student’s contact information not be released without the prior written consent of the eligible student or parent/legal guardian. ESSA requires school districts to inform secondary students and the parent/legal guardians of students their right to opt out of information being shared with military recruiters upon their request.

If this form is completed, signed, and returned to the student’s school, the school and school district shall not release the student’s name, address, and telephone listing to military recruiters without prior written consent of the eligible student or the parent/legal guardian. To initiate the “opt out” request, this form should be completed and signed by EITHER the student’s parent/legal guardian OR the eligible student.

As a student, I am exercising the right to “opt-out” and request that my own name, address and telephone number not be released to military recruiters.

As a parent, I am exercising the right to “opt-out” and request that you do not turn over the name, address and telephone number of the following student to military recruiters.
