We are providing distance learning opportunities to **ALL** of our students. This will help each student finish this school year and be prepared to enter next year ready to move forward. We will also include a few suggestions for additional activities that can help provide reinforcement/enrichment. Accommodations will be made for students on IEPs.

Only paper packets will be utilized in grades PK-4,

We are taking a blended approach for students in grades 5-12. Those who have access to their school Google accounts should check them Monday morning to determine whether or not they need to pick up any paper packets. Not all teachers will be using Google classroom for their assignments, so even if your child has access to technology, they may still need to pick up packets. If Google Classroom is not an option, we have listed below the ways that they can obtain their packets. Whether delivered by paper packet or Google Classroom, all activities can be completed at home and without the need for any technology or internet service.

Please do not allow this work to be a burden or worrisome. We know that many of our families are doing well to just maintain. No student will need to spend hours doing any of the work provided. Remember, this work is to strengthen the core standards/topics for each student. This is similar to the strategy that we would be using as we approached State Testing and the end of the school year.

Just so you are aware, grades will not be taken on any of the assigned activities, and none of the work will be collected. All students will receive a 100% for the fourth 9 weeks.

We will be contacting you to ensure that everything is going well and to answer any questions that you or your child(ren) may have. Please feel free to call or email us. Remember, this is new territory for all of us, so please be patient and supportive as we try to figure out the best way to ensure our students are still learning and growing.
