Suggested Time Frames:	How and what will students learn today?	For students:

Below are the Royal team guidelines that we are going to follow to make this as stress-free as possible.

- **ALL** work will be submitted through Google Classroom and **it will be graded**. Teachers will give you instructions on how to do this, depending on the assignment.
- Assignments can be submitted as soon as they are completed - you don't have to wait the week.
- Due dates will be posted with the assignment.
- Each class should have about 90-120 minutes of work a week. That is 30-40 minutes 3 days a week.

Assignments for Math, Reading and Choice will be posted each Monday, and **they will be due the following Monday**. There is still an expectation

that you read 120 pages/week. There are Cloud Library access instructions posted in the Royal Team Remote Resources classroom.

Assignments for your core classes will be posted Tuesday and will be ***due the following Tuesday***. There will be assignments in each core class each week.

Your teachers will be available by email, from 9am - 2pm each day to answer questions and give help.

Here is a sample schedule to give you an idea of how you might organize your week. This will be flexible to meet the needs of your family.

Monday: Do some work on assignments for Math, Choice & Reading.

Tuesday: Do some work on assignments for each of your core classes.

Wednesday: Do some work on assignments for Math, Choice & Reading.

Thursday: Do some work on assignments for each of your core classes.

Friday: Do some work on assignments for Math, Choice & Reading.

Weekend: Finish up your work and remember to post it in your Google Classrooms by the due date.

We may have the opportunity to “meet” with small groups of you using Google. If one of us has a group of students who need help with a particular assignment or concept, we might invite you to join a meeting. These meetings will be recorded, by order of the superintendent. Please EMAIL your teacher if you have questions or feel you need help. Your teacher will organize a group, if needed.

If you are bored and want more to do - please do! Learning doesn't have to be directed by us. Watch true stories or documentaries on whatever streaming service you have (like Netflix), and then Google more about it! Listen to podcasts. Read books. Go outside and just be in nature, run

about, play, write, create, color, play music. All these things are good for your brain and good for your well-being. If a topic you read about in a class is interesting to you EMAIL your teacher! We have more available for you to engage in!
