**RE: Brooks County High School COVID19 School Closure Instructions** 

To: Brooks County High School Parents and Students,

As most of you have heard, Georgia Governor Brian Kemp, announced on April 1st at 4:30 PM that all K-12 public schools would be closed for the remainder of the school year. BCHS faculty is working to collect information on the availability of online access and devices. Students should be receiving a call from their advisement teacher to check in, gather this information, as well as, phone numbers and email addresses for students and parents.

Students without devices who have access to wifi can checkout a chromebook on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>April 14th from 9am-12pm</u> at tents in front of BCHS. A signed contract accepting responsibility and return of the Chromebook in May will be required. Parents/Guardians must be present for students to check out a Chromebook and sign the checkout documents. All sites that are not directly related to education will be blocked from student use.

Students who are working in Odysseyware on courses should continue working to complete the courses in order to receive credit. Students needing modules graded or unlocked should contact Mrs. Gruno at <a href="mailto:agruno@brooks.k12.ga.us">agruno@brooks.k12.ga.us</a>. All students should check their Google Classroom daily and complete lessons as assigned by teachers. Teachers will be checking their email daily and will be available Monday to Friday from 8am to 4pm to help as needed. Teachers will have office hours in Google Classroom from 9am-11am Monday to Friday should students have questions.

Students who are failing courses at the end of the third nine weeks should reach out to their teachers in Google Classroom and work closely to repair the credit by completing incomplete or missing assignments, and new assignments on non-mastered standards. Final grades will be configured on <a href="Friday, May 22nd">Friday, May 22nd</a>. Set a routine daily to do work and keep up with virtual assignments.

Once the schedules go live, you will receive a notification.
