

#### Fall 2023 Student Expectations at Clarke High School Football Games

Clarke High School is extremely proud to welcome the students of Clarke Elementary, Clarke Middle School and Clarke High School, to all athletic events that the high school offers. These events are fun and exciting for all individuals. However, for the safety of all patrons, Clarke High School asks that all elementary, middle school and high school students abide by the following expectations while attending varsity football competitions at Clarke Stadium.

# Elementary School Students (PK - 5th Grade)

- Elementary students MUST have an adult with them to enter the game. No adult will result in no admittance to the game for that student.
- Elementary students are expected to be with an adult watching the game.
- Students are not allowed to bring in bags or backpacks to the stadium.
- There will be NO playing on the grassy area behind the stands.

# Middle School Students (6th - 8th Grade)

- Middle school students MUST sit in the designated "middle school" section on the north end of the stadium by the concession stand, unless they are sitting with their parents.
- Middle school students are expected to be in the designated area watching the game.
- Students are not allowed to bring in bags or backpacks to the stadium.
- There will be NO playing on the grassy areas.behind the stands.

# High School Students (9th - 12th Grade)

- High school students MUST sit/stand in the designated "high school" section on the south end of the home bleachers.
- High school students are expected to be in the stands watching the game and cheer on Clarke
- Students are not allowed to bring in bags or backpacks to the stadium.
- There will be NO playing on the grassy areas behind the stands .

#### **All Students**

- Students are NOT ALLOWED on the baseball or softball fields, or in a parking lot without an adult.
- Students are expected to support the concession stand and return to the stands after supporting the concession stand.
- Students are expected to return to the stands after using the restroom.
- No abusive or unruly behavior or language will be allowed.
- No throwing of objects or any projectile in the bleachers or any area around Clarke Stadium.
- No use of any prohibited items per policy of the IHSAA and IGHSAU (artificial noisemakers, unauthorized signs, etc.)

All student behavior at home and away activities is expected to be school appropriate and supportive of the students participating in the event. Any student whose actions are considered inappropriate and/or unsafe by school staff will be asked to sit with their parents or removed from the game. If asked to leave, students may not be allowed to return to other contests and admission to the event will not be refunded.

The staff of the Clarke Community Schools thanks all students and parents for their support of all those involved in activities during this season. We ask that everyone attending activities, watch and support those participating in the contests, and we look forward to having members of the student bodies at games to cheer on the Indians and help bring home an Indian victory!
