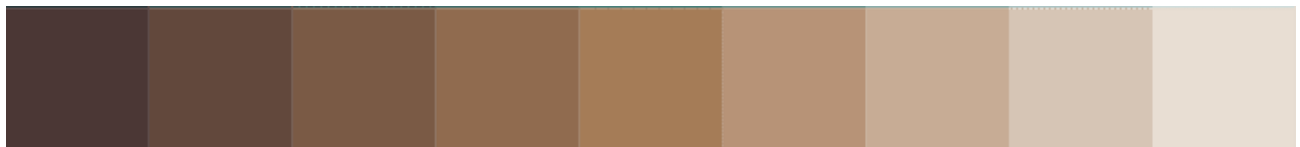


Mud Painting (High School)

- You will first need to collect some dirt. It will be helpful to find dark and light colored dirt. You can also change the value of your mud paint with the amount of water you add to the dirt.
- You will need something to make your painting on. This could be paper, cardboard, the inside of a cereal box, an old white t-shirt stretched over a board or cardboard, ect.
- You will need something to paint with. This could be paintbrushes, q-tips, your fingers, ect.
- First make a value scale.



- Finally, create a painting using any theme/subject matter.
