

Nauvoo-Colusa Remote Learning Plan

Nauvoo-Colusa strives to provide meaningful learning experiences to all of its students whether through face to face interaction, or through remote learning. The following plan's purpose is to provide guidance for the remote learning process.

Engaged Learning

Each student should be engaged in learning activities for a certain amount of time each day depending on the age of that child. The following chart shows what should be reasonably expected for each individual student.

Grade Level	Minimum Time	Maximum Time	Length of Time On Task
Pre-K	20 minutes/day	60 minutes/day	3-5 minutes
Kindergarten	30 minutes/day	90 minutes/day	3-5 minutes
Grades 1-2	45 minutes/day	90 minutes/day	5-10 minutes
Grades 3-5	60 minutes/day	120 minutes/day	10-15 minutes
Grades 6-8	Class: 15 minutes/day Total: 90 minutes/day	Class: 30 minutes/day Total: 180 minutes/day	1 subject area or class

Grading

Certain assignments will be graded and that grade will be recorded for the student. Those assignments will be clearly marked as such. Assignments that are to be graded will be aligned to Illinois State Standards. If a student does not complete and turn in that assignment, it will be marked as "incomplete". It is expected that the student will eventually complete that assignment.

Attendance

We are required to take attendance during this time. If your student is provided a learning packet for the week, and returns that packet with the work completed (or if some work is incomplete, but a valid reason is given) then that student will be counted for a full week's attendance. If your student is completing lessons on line, then attendance will be counted as per the classwork that student completes.

Communication

It is important that students be able to communicate with their teachers. All of our teachers can be reached via email. Lesson Delivery

We use a variety of methods to deliver work to the students. Most of the junior high teachers use email or other electronic communication to send and receive work from the students. Elementary teachers prepare packets of work for their students. For elementary students and junior high students who do not have internet access, work may be picked up and returned each Tuesday between 4:00 and 6:00 pm. If it is not possible to have someone pick up student work on Tuesdays, it will be mailed to the student.

Borrowing a laptop

If a student has internet access, but no computer to work from, their parent may sign out a laptop from the district for as long as this plan is in place, with the understanding that the laptop is to only be used for school work. As there are a limited number of laptops, they will be provided on a first-come, first served basis.

Free/reduced food distribution

One week's worth of breakfasts and lunches will be distributed on Tuesdays between 4:00 and 6:00 pm. Pick up point is the garage door at the back of the school. If you wish to be added to the list please contact the school. If you are unable to pick up the food, it will be delivered to you.

Transitioning back to regular classes

When/if we return to regular classes this year, the first two instructional periods of each class will be given over to review of previous material so that students may ask questions and have a refresher over the material. This will also be a time for those students who have received an incomplete to complete those assignments. No new homework or tests will be issued during this time.
