ADMISSION OF NON-RESIDENT STUDENTS

The Cape Elizabeth school board authorizes the superintendent to enroll without tuition and on a full-time basis, in accordance with applicable statutory provisions, persons who are not otherwise eligible for a free public education in Cape Elizabeth. Enrollment of any such persons shall be discretionary with the superintendent and shall be subject to such conditions as the superintendent deems necessary to avoid disruptive or adverse effects to the Cape Elizabeth school system.

The Cape Elizabeth school board authorizes the superintendent to accept non-resident students who have either been approved by their local school superintendent for a waiver or for whom tuition is paid. The tuition rate is to equal the state per pupil cost.

Enrollment of persons from outside of Cape Elizabeth shall be discretionary with the superintendent and shall be subject to such conditions as the superintendent deems necessary to avoid disruptive or adverse effects to the Cape Elizabeth school system.
