



Dear Parent/Guardian,

The purpose of this letter is to provide written notice regarding changes to the delivery of IEP services due to school building closure as a result of the Covid-19 Flu Pandemic.

These unprecedented times have dramatically interrupted our daily lives. While the uncertainty can be troubling, we believe we can emerge stronger in this time of crisis if we work together. The pandemic prevents face-to-face contact at this time; however, we are still available to support you and your student. The Special Education Department will reach out to you on a weekly basis to address concerns or questions about the educational activities provided for your student.

During the time period of April 6, 2020 through May 8, 2020, services will be delivered by a distance learning model as mandated by the State of Oklahoma. All IEP services will be provided at the monitor level during this time period. Services will automatically revert back to the original level of service indicated in your student's IEP when school resumes in the Fall (date unknown at this time).
