<p>Read a book. Divide the egg into 4 sections by drawing lines or using colored masking tape. Label the white spaces with any number you want to practice. You can use any numbers for this activity. Use mini chart stickers or have the students make circles on the egg. The children identify the numeral on each row, and count out the correct amount of mini stickers or circles to place on the egg.</p>	<p><b>Color a rainbow.</b> You will need 3-6 crayons, tape, and paper. Tape crayons together in groups of 3-6. Let your child draw freely on sheets of paper in multi-colored splendor.</p>	<p><b>Balance Beam.</b> Child will walk forward, backward, sideways. If you don't have a balance beam, use a chalk line drawn on the sidewalk, a board set on the ground, the end of a curb etc.</p>	<p>Identify appropriate clothing for specific weather. Example- what did you wear today? Why did you put that on? What would you wear when it's cold? Hot? Rainy? What would you wear to go swimming? Go to school? Go to bed? Go sledding? Walk in mud puddles?</p>
