TAX RATES

Operating tax millage to be levied for the 2023-2024 school year is 17.7141 mills non-homestead.

2023 Total Taxable Value	<u>\$206,676,560 (estimated)</u>
2023 Non-Homestead Taxable Value	<u>\$ 86,838,770 (estimated)</u>

In November 2019, voters approved a renewal of the 18 mill operating tax millage. This expires with the December 2024 levy.

There will not be a debt levy for 2023.
