

As we prepare for the 2023-24 school year, Food Services would like to highlight the many services available to school families.

MEAL ASSISTANCE and TEXTBOOK RENTAL. To receive Free or Reduced lunch benefits and Textbook Assistance, families must complete a Free/Reduced Application for the 23-24 School Year. Applications will be available after July 15, 2023. You can also visit the Plainfield website where you will find a link to fill out an electronic application, or you can go to the Meal Magic Family Portal at https://plainfield.familyportal.cloud. You do not need to make an account to fill out an application. DO NOT FILL OUT ANY APPLICATIONS PRIOR TO JULY 15TH.

ONLINE PAYMENTS FOR SCHOOL MEALS. You can find a link to make online payments on the Plainfield Community Schools Website at plainfield.k12.in.us > Quick Links > Food Services. The link to pay for school meals will be available a week before the start of school.

Student account balances from last year automatically roll over to the new school year. To create a new account, you'll need your student's ID number. NOTE: Financial institutions charge a processing fee for every debit/credit card transaction.

LOW BALANCE E-MAILS. You can set up a low balance email on the family portal along with setting any limits you would like for your child to have.

PROTECTING PRIVACY. We protect the privacy of all students, including whether or not they receive free or reduced-price meals or no-cost textbooks. Classmates and most staff will not know who receives this support. If your family qualifies, these programs can save you hundreds of dollars each year, so please be sure to apply. Also note that students who receive free or reduced-price meals may still purchase a la carte items if you put money in their account.

NO TIME FOR BREAKFAST? All Plainfield schools serve a variety of breakfast options to students each morning. Breakfast serving times are 8:30-8:50 a.m. for elementary.

OFFER VS. SERVE. The Plainfield Food Service department participates in the National School Lunch Program, and we use an offer vs serve menu. CASH-FREE CAFETERIA. Our cafeterias are cash-free. Elementary students who pay by cash will place lunch money in an assigned envelope in their classroom, and the Kitchen Manager will have it deposited in their account in time for lunch that day. At PCMS and PHS, students will insert their money in an envelope that then goes into one of several secure drop boxes located throughout the schools. Funds deposited at PCMS by 8:50 a.m., and at PHS by 10:15 a.m. will be applied to student accounts in time for that day's lunch. No cash will be taken (including giving change) at the register.

WELLNESS COMMITTEE: Plainfield Schools has a wellness committee that meets one to two times a year, the committee also puts on a health fair yearly. If you would like more information regarding the committee please check out the Food Services page for information

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Lunch Charging Procedures

Meal accounts for students should be consistently funded throughout the school year to avoid students needing to charge for a meal. However, the Board recognizes that an occasional emergency may make it necessary to charge for a meal. Families needing assistance to apply for free or reduced lunch should contact the Plainfield Community School Corporations Director of Food Service.

The Board's policy F176 and Superintendent's procedure related to meal charges shall be distributed in writing to all households at the start of each school year and to households transferring to the school or Corporation during the school year. Additionally, the Board's policy and Superintendent's procedure related to meal charges shall be distributed to all Corporation staff responsible for policy enforcement, including Corporation food service employees, accounting staff, and all other staff involved in enforcing any aspect of the meal charge policy. The Corporation's meal charging procedure is as follows:

- Significant negative lunch account balances shall not be permitted. A significant negative lunch account balance is any balance owed in excess of \$10.00;
- If a student has a significant negative lunch account balance, s/he shall be
 provided an alternate meal at a reduced price recommended by the
 Superintendent, the cost of which shall continue to accrue to his/her negative
 lunch account balance;
- No student shall be permitted to charge any à la carte food or beverage items;
- Parents/guardians will be notified via the Corporation's point of sale software and/or Parent Square once a student reaches a negative balance;
