

ESSER II AND III BACK-TO-SCHOOL PLAN: 2022-2023

- 1. No changes to the 22-23 Back to School plan- as stated at School Board meeting on DEcember 8,2022
- 2. Just as we did in 2021-2022. Plainfield Community Schools will continue with in-person learning for the 2022-2023 school year.
- 3. Plainfield Community Schools will continue to follow the guidance offered by federal, state and local health departments should an outbreak occur.
- 4. Classrooms, Cafeterias and all learning environments for all grade levels, will function as they did prior to COVID-19.
- 5. Athletics, Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Activities:
 - a. Before- and after-school student activities will return to normal.
- 5. Volunteers: Process will function as it did prior to COVID 19.
 - b. Volunteers must complete a background check prior to volunteering at school.
- 6. Transportation:
 - a. Will function as they did prior to COVID 19
- 6. Update changes
 - b. The board authorizes the administration to update changes to these plans on an as needed basis.

ESSER I, II and III Financial Update

In order to qualify for ESSER II and III funds, the Local Education Agency is required to submit details on:

- the school district's plan to return to in-person instruction,
- efforts made to gather public comment on that plan, and
- post the plan on the district website within 30 days of receiving ESSER III funds.

At the December 8, 2022 Plainfield School Board meeting, the plan for the ESSER funds will be open for public comment.

- ESSER II: \$1,154,110.39
- ESSER III: \$2,591,968.00

The ESSER II and III funds will be used to support three instructional areas:

- 1. Technology (\$776,000)
 - a. Instructional software
 - b. Chromebooks
 - c. Charging cabinets
 - d. Chromebook covers
- 2. Student Support (\$2,300,000)
 - a. Media Center and Imagination lab Instructional Assistants
 - b. Behavior Specialists
 - c. Support curriculum and instruction for all learners
 - d. Reduce Class sizes.
- 3. Learning Loss (\$700,00)
 - a. Support STEM Programming at the Imagination Lab (Pk-5)
 - b. Programming for learning loss
 - i. Summer remediation programs
 - ii. Tutor before and after school
 - iii. Remediation programs throughout the school year.
