GUIDANCE AND FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Topic	Question	Guidance
End of School Year	What will be the last day of the school year?	May 15, 2020 will be the last student day of the 2019-2020 school year. eLearning will be conducted on Tuesdays, Wednesday, and Thursdays; however, the week of May 11, eLearning will be conducted on Tuesday through Friday. Students are expected to complete their assignments and pass their courses. Any high school and some middle school students who do not pass their current courses will need to repeat the course during the next school year. Elementary students who do not complete and pass their course work are at risk at not moving on to the next grade in the fall.
Graduation Requirements	What are the graduation requirements for the class of 2020?	Students need to earn their required credits to graduate and pass their trimester 3 courses. If a student needed to pass a state assessment or meet a graduation pathway to graduate, that requirement has been waived. Check back for updates or information coming from Mrs. Longenbaugh and/or Mrs. Munson.
Graduation Ceremony	Will there be a graduation ceremony?	East Noble School Corporation is hopeful that a graduation ceremony can be held on the scheduled date of May 31. Check back for updates.
Senior Activities	Will any senior activities be held?	At this time, the senior honors night, senior breakfast, and the Roots and Wings Top 10 dinner are cancelled.
Prom	Will prom be held?	The 2020 ENHS Prom has been cancelled.

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Obtaining personal items from classrooms and lockers	When can a student return to school and clean out their lockers and/or desks?	ENSC is hopeful that students may return to buildings in some way to clean out their lockers and/or desks. If there is something that a student has at school that he/she absolutely must have during the State mandated “Stay at Home” order, please contact the building principal to set up an appointment. Check back for updates.
School owned resources	How do I return library books, classroom books, athletic uniforms, and other items that belong to the school?	Please collect these items and have them ready to return to the school buildings toward the end of May. Check back for an update.
Technology	What are we to do with iPads and laptops at the end of the year?	Students in grades Kindergarten through 11 <sup>th</sup> grade will keep their device through the summer. Eighth grade students will return their device in the fall or may pay \$30 to keep the device. They will receive a new laptop as a freshman in the fall. Senior students will be able to purchase their device for \$30. Information will be sent later this week to students and their parents regarding the procedure for purchasing their laptop. All negligent damages are the responsibility of the student.
Summer School	Will summer school be held?	That is currently an unknown by the state. Check back for updates.
Lunches	Will lunches continue to be delivered during April and May?	Yes, lunches will continue to be delivered to the 16 locations on Mondays (two lunches) and Wednesdays (three lunches) until the social distancing rule is cancelled. Check back for updates.
Summer Lunches	Will summer lunches be offered?	This is on hold for the time being. Check back for updates.
Lunch Funds	How will current lunch balances be handled?	Students in grades K-11 will have their lunch funds carry over into the 2020-2021 school year. Senior student lunch funds will be reimbursed to those families who email Marcos Reyna at <a href="mailto:mreyna@eastnoble.net">mreyna@eastnoble.net</a> before May 15, 2020.
Impact Institute	Will students receive credit for Trimester 3?	This is an Impact Institute decision and the students’ teacher will need to be contacted.
Book rental	Will refunds be given for book rental?	Book rental fees will not be refunded. Expenses have been incurred for the district and most resources, which are included in

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		book rental, are still in use. Check back for updates to high school fees.
Preschool fees	Will preschool fees be reimbursed?	Any preschool fees paid will be rolled over into kindergarten book rental for the 2020-2021 school year. If you would like your fees reimbursed now, please contact the preschool building principal for a refund by May 15, 2020.
Yearbooks	When will yearbooks be completed?	For elementary and middle school yearbooks, the building principals will send information to you. The high school yearbook development will continue as planned. The yearbook will be completed on schedule and be distributed in the fall. Work Permits	How can a teenager obtain a work permit?	Students do not need to obtain a work permit until after May 1. After May 1, if a student needs a work permit, he/she will need to set an appointment time by calling 347-2032 and arrange an appointment.
