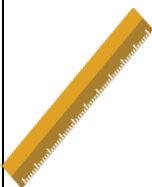


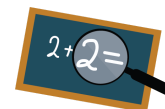


General information

Transitioning to virtual instruction can be a challenge for both parents and students. Within this document you will find valuable tips to help with the transition as well as resources for you to utilize during this time. Remember, this is a learning time for all involved! We know that parents are doing their best to support learning at home, and we are here to help. The lessons your child will complete in the Edmentum platform will contain videos and explanations of activities. If you or your child need help at any time, contact your child's teacher. They are available during the hours of 8:00-3:30 to support students.



Your child will complete work in English, math, science, and history throughout the week. The Edmentum platform allows students to self-pace through the learning. Parents are encouraged to set a schedule that allows time for students to complete their work each day. You will find a sample schedule below to help you plan and a blank schedule template you can use to set a schedule that works for your family.



Your child should spend approximately 4 hours per day completing their assignments. Don't forget to schedule in time to move, exercise, take a break and get outside.

Students enrolled in AP and Concurrent Courses will continue to receive instruction directly from their teacher and will not be using Edmentum.
