Make your target sound(s) out of playdoh then talk about what words have this sound.	Play Red Light, Green Light to work on following directions and taking turns.	While looking at a wordless picture book, use smooth speech to describe the pictures.

\*Modeling sounds correctly is most effective. Continue to model sounds even when your child imitates the word back incorrectly.
