Vehicle registration is **mandatory** in order to park your vehicle on school property. If no parking permit is displayed, vehicle will be ticketed and not allowed on campus until parking permit is displayed. If vehicle or insurance company change during the school year, a copy of that information must be provided to the Assistant Principal's Office **within 10 school days**.

Wayland-Cohocton Central School is not responsible for theft of valuables from inside vehicles or any damage that may occur to a vehicle while parked on school property.

Refundable Deposit: A \$10.00 refundable deposit for the parking permit is due prior to its issuance. This charge will be refunded at the end of the student's senior year, provided they turn in the parking permit that was issued to them. If the parking permit is not returned at the end of the senior year, the deposit will then be forfeited. Seniors must turn in their parking permits by graduation practice.

Students **MUST** park in the Field House parking lot during school hours. There will be **NO** parking allowed in any Faculty/Visitor parking lots, for any reason. Anyone found in violation of the Parking Policy will be ticketed and will be directed to move their vehicle to the Field House parking lot. After one violation of the Parking Policy students may be subject to a discipline referral.

The speed limit on school property is 10 mph. Operating a vehicle in a reckless manner, speed too fast for conditions, following too close, etc. will result in the loss of driving privileges for the school year.

Remember, **driving is a privilege, not a right.** You can lose your driving privilege.

School buses have the **right of way** at any time on the road. Vehicle operators must use caution not to interfere with school bus travel.

Pedestrians have the **right of way** in the crosswalks; please stop to allow pedestrians to cross.

Students may not leave school while school is in session without **WRITTEN** parental permission and school approval. Students may not go to their cars during the school day without permission from the Assistant Principal's office, except designated National Honor Society students.

I understand the rules and regulations for student drivers. The misuse of driving privileges while on school property will result in the termination of driving privileges.
