

**BARNEVELD SCHOOL DISTRICT
PUBLIC ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL EVENTS**

The Board welcomes the attendance of members of the community at athletic and other public events held by the schools in the District, but the Board also acknowledges its duty to maintain order and preserve the facilities of the District during the conduct of such events.

The Board directs that no alcoholic beverage or other controlled substance be possessed, consumed, or distributed nor does any betting occur at any function occurring on District premises.

No qualified person with a disability will, because the District's facilities are inaccessible to or unusable by persons with disabilities, be denied the benefits of, be excluded from participation in, or otherwise be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity to which Section 504/ADA applies.

The Board holds the legal authority to bar the attendance of or remove any person whose conduct may constitute a disruption on District property or at a school event. School administrators have the authority to call law enforcement officials if a person violates posted regulations or does not leave District property when requested. They are also authorized to use detectors and other devices to better protect the safety and well-being of participants and visitors.

If a student, a non-enrolled minor, or adult is asked to leave or is removed from a school event, no admission fees shall be refunded.

Persons attending school events are subject to the prohibitions on use of tobacco pursuant to Policy 831 – Use of Tobacco on School Premises.

Persons attending school events are subject to the provisions of Policy 832 - Weapons.

The Board is aware of the increasing desire of many parents and other members of an audience to make audio and/or video recordings of school events. Such recordings can be made by parents or other members of the audience without restriction if the performance is not of copyrighted material. However, if the performance is of copyrighted material, recording of any kind is prohibited unless the district specifically announces and grants permission at the time of the performance.
