RESOLUTION OF URGENT NECESSITY – (Addendum)

(12-191) Motion was made by Mr. Carfrey, seconded by Mr. Ruff to approve the following resolution of urgent necessity:

DECLARING AN URGENT NECESSITY, WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING, AND AUTHORIZING AGREEMENT TO UPGRADE THE EXISTING 10,000 GALLON DIESEL TANK.

WHEREAS, the Board previously engaged Michael E. Clark & Associates and Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil to provide a plan to upgrade the existing 10,000 gallon diesel tank (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the plan prepared by Michael E. Clark & Associates and Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil, is attached hereto as Exihibit "A" and Exhbit "B"; and

WHEREAS, based upon the amount of materials and work anticipated, Michael E. Clark & Associates and Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil estimates that the

reasonable costs associated with this repair plan is approximately \$38,500; and

WHEREAS, time is of the essence for the upgrade of the existing 10,000 gallon diesel tank because the Ohio State Fire Marshall has declared this to be a significant safety concern; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the District's best interest to waive the competitive bidding requirements within the Ohio Revised Code to expedite the work in order to remove all safety concerns related to the existing diesel tank and to protect school property from any damage,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Westfall Local School District as follows:

- 1. Based upon the recommendation of the Superintendent, the Board waives the competitive bidding requirements of the Ohio Revised Code Section 3313.46 to upgrade the existing 10,000 gallon diesel tank, as described herein based on the existence of an urgent necessity and the ongoing risk that additional school property may be at risk as permitted under Section 3313.46(A)
- 2. Based upon the recommendation of the Superintendent and Michael E. Clark & Associates and Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil, the Board finds that it is in the best interest of the Board and the District to authorize the Superintendent to execute a contract, in an amount not to exceed \$38,500, with Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil to upgrade the existing 10,000 gallon diesel tank. Accordingly, the Board authorizes the Superintendent to execute a contract on behalf of the District with Lemmco LLC and Guttman Oil to upgrade the existing 10,000 gallon diesel tank in an amount not to exceed \$38.500.
- 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of the Board concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board, and that all deliberations of the Board and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22
