BUSING OF WESTFALL STUDENTS FROM THE MT. STERLING UNITED METHODIST DAY CARE

- 1. The Superintendent recommends approving grandfathering in the busing of our students from the Mt. Sterling United Methodist Church Day Care to Westfall Elementary School and that this sets no precedent for considering transportation in the future from other day care centers that may be established outside of our district.
- 2. The Superintendent recommends approval of transporting our students from the Mt. Sterling United Methodist Day Care by charging a per student fee. The church is located 0.8 of a mile outside our boundaries. This would result in a bus traveling 3.2 miles daily to and from this location. This would equal 576 miles traveled per year. The State indicated to us that it costs our district \$2.53 per mile for a bus to be operated. This total would then cost the district \$1,457.28 per year. Dividing this total by the number of students who would be transported would determine the fee charged per student to use this service. Bus routes will have to be re-routed to accommodate this action and the day care would be a designated pick up site for our students.
