Alternative Plans for Spring 2020

As of this writing we are still hopeful that we can return to school yet this year, but also want to prepare alternate plans for many upcoming end-of-year events so families can know how they will be handled if Remote Learning continues through the end of the 2019-2020 school year. Following is a summary of how we plan to proceed.

Schneider

- Knight Walk - Cancelled for 2019-2020 school year. Discussing moving 2020-2021 event back to fall.
- Gr. 2/3 Spring Concert – Reschedule in May if we return; otherwise Mrs. Weiler is creating a video concert that can be shared.
- Spring Pictures - Reschedule in May if we return; no spring pictures otherwise.

BRIJHS

- 4th Grade Transition Activities- Reschedule for May if we return; otherwise school personnel will develop a welcome video for students and host a special open house the week before school for just 4th graders.
- Knight Walk-Cancelled, but students will still be able to turn in forms and get their prizes. Donations are due May 1.
- Spring Sports & Activities Awards- Reschedule for May if we return; otherwise Boosters will create individual posts about each participant similar to how the high school is spotlighting seniors. Awards/plaques will be ordered when the stores open back up.
- Tri-School Band Festival-Cancelled for this year.
- Spring Pops Concert- Will be held 5/19; otherwise cancel if we do not return.
- Promotion-Hold in May if we return; otherwise we will have a dance in August (or whenever restrictions are lifted). Students will still get their certificates/covers. Students voted on this.
- Spring pictures-Will be rescheduled if we return, if not no spring pictures.

BRHS

- Graduation-Hold as normally planned if we are in session on Sunday, May 17 at 2 p.m. Otherwise, we will conduct graduation at the same time and day, but in the circle drive at BRHS. Hope to broadcast speeches and program via radio or livestream. Graduates and family members will drive through for the handing out of diplomas at portico by the gym. Afterwards, the entire group parade in their cars through FC, Mansfield, and Bellflower.
- Honors Night-Hold in May if we return; otherwise cancel and publicize names of scholarships and recipients. (Note: If we have to cancel and a scholarship donor would like to personally award their scholarship, please contact the school office and we will video the presentation and post it to the district Facebook page.)
- Prom- Mrs. Lagle and Post Prom Committee are developing plans to reschedule after “Stay at Home” order is lifted.
- FFA Awards Banquet-Reschedule for early June if “Stay at Home” order is lifted
- Spring Play-TBA-may become Summer Play
