## Needville High School Scholarship Fund

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide scholarship awards to students who have the desire to further their education, have demonstrated good citizenship, and have financial need. This is a renewable scholarship. Applications are available in the counselor's office or at [www.nhsscholarship.org](http://www.nhsscholarship.org). **Applications must be postmarked by April 15<sup>th</sup>.**

## San Bernard Watershed Scholarship Program

Applicants for this scholarship must demonstrate a direct connection between the career they intend to pursue and the betterment of the environment. Possible career paths might include: environmental sciences, environmental law, agriculture, certain engineering disciplines, science education, and scientific research. ## Bonnie Hopkins Memorial Scholarship

## Needville ISD Scholarships

***Students may apply for both the NISD Academic and Employee Scholarships.*** Students in the top 10% of their graduating class are eligible to apply for the NISD Academic Scholarships. All students are eligible to apply for the NISD Employee Scholarship. Your parent does not have to be an employee of NISD to apply for the Employee Scholarship. Eligible students should be in good standing at Needville High School, plan to attend a post-secondary institution, and must have mastered all EOC exams.

Applications are available in the counselor's office. **NISD Scholarships should be returned to Mrs. Orsak by April 22<sup>nd</sup>.**

#### **Novosad Family Scholarship**
