## About Our School

Jefferson County North, Unified School District #339, is located in the northeast corner of Jefferson County. The district encompasses 114 square miles. The majority of this land is in Jefferson County, with very small sections extending into Atchison and Leavenworth counties. This area includes the two towns of Nortonville and Winchester.

Within the 2-A school district, approximately 450 students attend grades preschool through 12 with an average class size of about 20 students.

USD #339 employs 74 people; 3 administrators, 41 certified staff members and 30 classified.

The district has impressive, well-maintained, technology rich attendance centers including an elementary middle school (Preschool-8<sup>th</sup> grade) facility built in 1997, located in Nortonville, and a recently renovated high school (9-12<sup>th</sup> grade) facility built in 1980, located in Winchester. The other main building in the district serves as the district office and high school technology center, also located in Winchester.
