We're excited to announce that Richmond Hill Primary will be participating in the OPEN National Field Day event on Friday, May 8th!

Field Day is an important tradition at our school. It's always a fun way for our students and our staff to be active, promote teamwork, and practice good sportsmanship. We feel that OPEN's National Field Day is the perfect opportunity for our students to get the field day experience from home. The event will also be an excellent way for teachers, students, and families to connect as a school community.

All National Field Day events are designed to be done indoors or outdoors using common household items. You won't be asked to purchase any specialized equipment or supplies.

Here's how it will work:

- Our school is now registered as a participant in this event. Families are encouraged to register as well so you can receive info and updates directly from OPEN Phys Ed, but it's not a requirement. [Click here to register your family.](#)
- As a part of registration, you will receive Field Day Friday email updates each week with new event resources. We will also forward these resources out to all Primary parents each Friday.
- You can also find updates via social media using the hashtag #NationalFieldDay.
- By April 17th, your family will receive a set of event cards that you can use to begin practicing. You will also receive a participant practice sheet for tracking progress.
- Your family will be asked to choose a minimum of 4 events to complete on Field Day. However, you may complete as many events as you'd like.
- From May 3rd thru 7th, follow #NationalFieldDay on social media and watch the Field Day Torch travel across the country in preparation for the main event.
- On May 8th, your family will participate in events, complete an official score card, share photos and videos on the Richmond Hill Primary School Facebook page. You may also post your photos and videos to social media using #NationalFieldDay.
- After the event, your student will submit their scorecard via email to Ms. Williams (awilliams@bryan.k12.ga.us).
- Every student that completes at least 4 events will receive an OPEN National Field Day e-certificate.

We look forward to your participation, and we're hopeful that your entire family will use National Field Day as a fun and meaningful way to be physically active together and support our school.
