The regular meeting of the Saranac Community Schools Board of Education was held on Thursday, February 2, 2017 in the Library, Saranac Jr/Sr High School, 150 Pleasant Street, Saranac, MI.

The meeting was called to order by Brent Denny, President at 6:02 p.m.

Present: Courtnay, Denny, Doll, Hawkins, Jackson, Price, & VanKuiken.

Kevin Courtnay led in the Pledge of Allegiance.

STUDENT HEARING: Motion by Hawkins, supported by Price that the Saranac Board of Education go into Closed Session for the purpose of a student hearing at 6:03 p.m. returning to open session at 7:03 p.m. Yes Votes: Courtnay, Denny, Doll, Hawkins, Jackson, Price & VanKuiken. Motion Carried.

Motion by Doll, supported by Hawkins that the Saranac Board of Education *not expel* the student. Yes Votes: Courtnay, Denny, Doll, Hawkins, Jackson, Price & VanKuiken. Motion Carried.

<u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>: Minutes from regular meeting dated January 19, and Finance Committee meeting dated January 31, 2017 were approved as presented.

COMMENTS FROM GUESTS – AGENDA ITEMS: None

STUDENT REPORT: Bayleigh Fountain from Student Council reported that student council members attended the Special Olympics in Traverse City today helping with student activities. The "Purple Out" basketball game is tomorrow night, and the Snowcoming Dance is Saturday night. At our recent blood drive 42 people were able to donate.

Students, Elijah Powell & Mitchell Jackson from the Elementary School Student Council, reported in October they participated with the student council leadership from the Jr/Sr High School and did a sock collection for the Saranac community. It was called Socktober. Mrs. Chipman's 6th grade class brought in the most pairs of socks and won an extra recess. They held a JDRF (Juvenile Diabetes Research Foundation) Sneaker Fundraiser with the 5th grade selling the most sneakers. They helped with the Veterans Day Assembly. They held their annual "Turkey Trot" in November. They had Toys for Tots drop-off at the Elementary and collected 126 toys, and they participated in the WZZM 13 School Spirit Challenge. They have a Box Tops competition going on, the class who brings in the most will get a free movie and popcorn. Their building will be doing a "Spirit Week" from February 20-24th.

<u>ADMINISTRATOR'S REPORT</u>: Elementary Principal, Jason Smith reported they are participating in a food drive during the week leading up to Super Bowl 2017 from January 30th thru February 3^{rd;} all donations go directly to Saranac's Food Pantry. The students will be selling Candy Grams and Carnations for Valentine's Day. Mr. Smith will be attending baseball practice with the University of Michigan baseball team on Saturday.

Jr/Sr High Principal, Josh Leader reported JSH first semester report cards will be mailed home to parents next week. We have been finalizing online grades for students who completed Michigan Virtual School courses, as the MVS semester ended a week after ours. Students will begin the process of scheduling 2017-18 classes in about a week, as they complete surveys selecting potential elective courses and signing up for the opportunity to take online classes. Thank you to Diana Smith and the High School Student Council for organizing the "Snowcoming" dance to be held this Saturday evening from 8:00-11:00 PM. This is our second semi-formal dance for high school students.

Thank you to Joel Manion and the junior high student council, as they also organized a dance last Saturday for 7th and 8th grade students. The theme of the dance was "Movies." Prizes were awarded to students with movie-themed costumes. Matt Stauffer and the high school band will be holding their annual Pre-Festival Concert Monday, February 6th at 7:00 PM in the JSH auditorium. Thank you to Mandy Mutschler, all of the Purple Game Student Committee members, and our sponsors for their role in organizing this week's Purple Game and Spirit Week festivities. This process takes several months and is a major undertaking in the Relay for Life fundraising effort. We will share totals once the game is complete. Former MSU basketball player and current public speaker Anthony Ianni spoke to students on January 25th about positive self-image and the impacts of bullying. Thank you to Phyllis Plumley, who arranged this opportunity.

INSTRUCTIONAL HIGHLIGHT- Saranac Express: Teacher, Diana Smith along with some of her Journalism Class students, Elissa Mutschler, Dakota Ostrander, Bayleigh Fountain, Emily Denny, Michael Wojcik and Delaney Washburn discussed how the Saranac Express Website was formed and student run. They discussed how students get articles and pictures for the website and how they maintain it. They also thanked Barb Pachulski and Tom Westbrook for providing pictures for the website as well. They are amazed how well the class has stepped up and provided leadership for the Saranac Express and Yearbook.

<u>SCHOOL SAFETY RADIO PRESENTATION:</u> Superintendent, Maury Geiger reported that many thanks to our newest board member, Kevin Courtnay, and his business, Crouch Communications, for working with Motorola, and having Saranac Community Schools be the recipient of "state of the art" new technology that will be a model for the State of Michigan in school safety. Rich Uslan from Motorola and Stan Hoskins, Ionia County Sherriff's Office Emergency Manager along with Mr. Courtnay discussed how this new communication devise will work with the safety response alert systems in Ionia County.

Mr. Geiger thanked Motorola for donating the radios and to Crouch Communications for donating the materials and time for installation. This will enhance the emergency plan we already have in place for the safety and security of our students and staff.

They are donating 3 radios with a value of over \$10,000 to our district.

<u>1st AMENDMENT BUDGET PROJECTIONS UPDATE</u>: Superintendent Geiger presented the most up to date first budget amendment projections of revenues and expenditures showing a fund balance of 2.23%. The board will be approving the 1st budget amendment in March, and Mr. Geiger will be presenting the 1st draft of the 2017/2018 school year budget.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT: Mr. Geiger reported Consumer's Energy was coming in tomorrow morning for a meeting on the energy project. They had a Promise Committee meeting this week. The committee had a successful donation mailing that went out in December. On February 23 at 7 pm Mr. Geiger will be presenting the budget and school finances to the community. There is a sale pending on the house, and he is awaiting the independent appraisal on the Middle School. Elementary Principal, Jason Smith is looking at options for the 2nd grade class size. March 1st is the High School Band Districts at Jenison High School. They have a prefestival concert on Monday, February 6, at 7 pm in the auditorium.

BOARD REQUESTS/REPORTS: Board Secretary, David Price called for a Special Workshop meeting for Thursday, February 9^{th,} at 7 pm with Michigan Association of School Boards.

Mr. Price also mentioned that \$25,000 has been sent down to the Grand Rapids Community Foundation from the Promise funds.

Some of the board members attended classes at Kent ISD last week thru the Michigan Association of School Boards.

A board member had the opportunity to be a part of an online focus group through the Michigan Department of Education regarding ESSA (Every Student Succeeds Act). There were about 20 parents that took part in this.
