- Choose any one topic from the list above and write a minimum 1000 word article on your chosen topic.

- Our aim is to spread the word about this initiative as far and wide as possible, thereby increasing awareness and participation in the cause of fighting drug abuse, as well as to give as many people as possible a chance to win the scholarship. If you share this opportunity via social media please make sure the link is “clickable” and that it correctly takes readers to this scholarship page. This step is not mandatory, neither is it a criterion for judgment, but your participation in spreading the word is highly appreciated.
- The article should be an unpublished, original work of the applicant. Plagiarism will result in immediate disqualification.
- Only one entry per person per year.
- Participants are not allowed to contact the judges by any means for any reason. Doing so will result in immediate disqualification.
- The judges' decision is final and indisputable.
- Applications received post-deadline will be disqualified.
- The scholarship is only awarded to one student per year, however, we have the option to award more than one scholarship.
- Bio-Med Testing Services/Wienhoff Drug Testing will make every reasonable attempt to read and judge every article,
- The awarded scholarship can be revoked immediately if it is found that the participant has broken any of the scholarship guideline rules.
- Under no circumstances will Bio-Med Testing Services/Wienhoff Drug Testing be liable to the participant for any indirect, punitive, special or consequential damages.
- In the case of the number of submissions exceeding expectations, Bio-Med Testing Services/Wienhoff Drug Testing may change the submission deadline to an earlier date. Applicants are encouraged to submit their essays as early as possible.
- In the event that Bio-Med Testing Services/Wienhoff Drug Testing is forced to change or alter some or all of these rules, applicants shall be notified via email. These changes will therefore be considered read and accepted. If participants find the changes unacceptable, they may withdraw from this essay contest.
