

School Take-Home Packet Drop Off & Pick Up Information

Dates: Friday, April 17th and Friday, April 24th

When: 7 am to 4 pm

Where: Main school hallway

What: Parents will be able to drop off packets and pick up new packets. Each EK-5 teacher will have a separate table with new take-home packets on top of the table and a bin underneath the table to drop off completed packets.

There will be two separate tables for students in grades 6-12 who need to drop/pick up items.

Library Books: Library books should be returned in the general library bin in the main hallway. If you have arranged with Mrs. Meissner, the school librarian, to check out new library books, those books will be in a take-home bag located next to your child's take-home packet. New books cannot be checked out unless all other books are returned.

Bus Route Option: For those of you who live on a scheduled bus route and are unable to come by the school on Friday, busses will drop off and pick school work on during the **lunch route**. Please contact the school prior to Thursday at 3:30 pm if you would like to make any changes to your prior bus for drop off/pick up arrangements.

School Closure: The Governor's initial March 26th "Stay at Home" directive was also extended to April 24th. The directive does not change how schools are operating, so schools will continue to operate under the plans submitted to the Governor and all previous education related directives from the Governor.
