

# REVISED SCHEDULE: AP EXAMS 2020

The College Board will send online exams to students' homes this year due to the unprecedented pandemic. Each consists of a 45-minute session and may be completed on a home computer or from a cell phone. College Board recommends use of a laptop or home PC because this permits the ability to type the essays. If on phone only, students have an extra step of writing essays, photographing the material, and uploading to the computer. Phone also may take extra time to read test questions on the DBQ or Free Response items. All 45 minutes should be used, and the student will be responsible for keeping track of the time. A timer will appear on the screen.
