## The New Helper

### Acts 2

Remember how Jesus had told His disciples that God would send them His Gift, the Helper? Do you remember what that Gift was going to be called? That's right, the gift of the Holy Spirit! So, the disciples all waited together in the city of Jerusalem.

Suddenly, it happened! There was a very loud sound like a mighty wind (put your hands over your ears for a few seconds like you're hearing a sound that's too loud)! Then, the Bible says that something that looked like a flame of fire came on each of them! "All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit" (God's gift of the New Helper!). That same day, many people who spoke different languages were visiting the city of Jerusalem for a festival celebration called, Pentecost (say "Pentecost"). The Holy Spirit caused Jesus' disciples to start speaking in all these different languages that they had never known before! The Holy Spirit was helping them tell about our wonderful God to all those people!

As you can imagine, the people visiting Jerusalem that day were shocked! (Show on your face what their faces might have looked like.) They said, "What does this mean?" Peter, one of Jesus' disciples, told them "...let me explain this to you...God says, I will pour out my Spirit... and everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved...you...put Him (Jesus) to death... But God raised Him from the dead".

The people who were listening to Peter said, "...what shall we do?" Peter told them, "Repent ( that means tell God you're sorry for the wrong things you've done and stop doing them) and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. (Remember when Jesus' cousin, John, baptized people to show that they were sorry for their sins and wanted to follow God?) **And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.**" The Bible says that about three thousand people did that day!

How about you? What are those, "5 Things We Need to Know"? Have you asked Jesus to forgive your sins, told Him that you want Him to be your Lord (your Boss) and become God's child? If you have, then God's Holy Spirit lives inside of you helping you to live like Jesus taught us.

## The Lame Man Leaps!

Acts 3:1-10

One afternoon, two of Jesus' disciples, Peter and John, were going to the temple church to pray. They saw a lame man (a man who couldn't walk from the time he was born) by the temple gate. Each day, someone had to put the lame man there so that he could ask people for money to buy food. (Pretend that you're a lame man asking for money. Hold out your hand.)

Peter said to the man, "Look at us!" When the man did, Peter told him, "Silver and gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk."

Peter took the man's right hand (hold out your right hand) and helped him stand. The Bible says, "instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong. He jumped to his feet and began to walk." The man walked with Peter and John into the temple church, "walking and jumping, and praising God."

All the people standing around knew this was the same man they had seen sitting there for years asking for money because he could not walk or stand. The Bible says, "they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him." (What would the expression be on your face if you had just seen this happen?)

## The Disciples Speak Out

Acts 3,4

After the lame man had been healed, the people who watched it happen came running to Peter and John. Peter told the people that Jesus had healed the man. He said, "You killed (Jesus) the author of life, but God raised Him from the dead. We are witnesses of this. (Peter and John had seen it happen.) By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through Him that has completely healed him, as you can all see...Repent, then, turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out..."

Then some of the same men who had Jesus killed came and put Peter and John in jail for the night! They didn't like that Peter and John were telling people that Jesus had come back to life. But many of the people who listened to what Peter had said, believed in Jesus that day!

Peter and John were taken out of jail the next day and told not to tell people about Jesus anymore! (Would you be scared to talk about Jesus if that had happened to you? Do you think Peter and John stopped? No!) The disciples said, "As for us, we cannot help speaking about what we have seen and heard."

The men who had put them in jail told them again not to talk about Jesus. But they let Peter and John go because they couldn't decide what else to do! So many people who had seen the lame man walk were praising God for healing him (say, "Yeah, God!")!

When Peter and John went home and told the other disciples what had happened, they prayed together. They asked God to help them, and He did! The Bible say, "they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God **boldly.**"
