

## Superintendent's Report (Discussion)

- Legislature won't make the authorization to approve funds for DESE to distribute to schools next year until May.
- Our DESE funds are currently calculated using the pandemic provision (the highest ADA going back to 2020) impacting our allotment for Classroom Trust Fund, Prop. C & Small Schools.
- Different bills looking at increasing the State Adequacy Target. It has been stagnant at \$6,375.00 for years. Also group forming to challenge DESE to form a Blue Ribbon Panel to change foundation formula.
- Another factor that will impact our funding is the loss of the Community Eligibility Provision. Our WADA will be tied to the number of families qualifying for F/R Lunch. We are just over 50% F/R under the new system and were 100% previously.








#### 3 - 6 MAP Results: 2021-22




#### 3 - 6 MAP Results: 2020-21




#### 3 - 6 MAP Results: 2018-19






#### 7th Grade ELA MAP Score Distribution




#### 8th Grade ELA MAP Score Distribution




# **English I EOC Score Distribution**




**English II EOC Score Distribution** 




#### 7th Grade Math MAP Score Distribution






# Fall Algebra I EOC Score Distribution




Algebra I EOC Score Distribution




# Algebra II EOC Score Distribution




### Geometry EOC Score Distribution




#### 8th Grade Science MAP Score Distribution




## **Biology EOC Score Distribution**




# Physical Science EOC Score Distribution




# ADJUSTED APPROACH TO HS EOC and MS MAP

- Test results made available to staff for analysis


