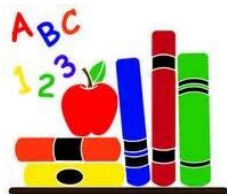

## Preschool Curriculum

At Lineham School Early Learning Center, our curriculum is designed by our teachers and is aligned with the Rhode Island Early Learning and Development Standards (RIELDS). Each of the nine domains outlined in the RIELDS is addressed through carefully designed, developmentally appropriate activities and play experiences. Teachers provide a range of activities from teacher directed, to small group learning, to free choice play to target all areas of development.

Our curriculum includes physical health and motor development, social and emotional development, language development, literacy, cognitive development, mathematics, science, and social studies.

## School and Enrollment Information

Lineham School Early Learning Center is an integrated program, serving children of all abilities. The preschool is available to children 3 - 5 years old who are residents of Exeter and West Greenwich. Selection for enrollment occurs in April for the subsequent year.

Any applications not selected will be placed on a waiting list according to date that application is received. All children must be screened by Child Outreach as part of the application process.



## Child Outreach Screenings

Child Outreach Screening is a service sponsored by the Rhode Island Department of Education and offered through our school district.

These screenings help to identify areas of developmental delay or difference that may interfere with learning. Children ages 3, 4, and 5 should be screened, please call Lineham School at 397-3771 to set up an appointment for a free developmental screening.

## Preschool Schedule

Lineham School offers ½day programs with morning and afternoon sessions. All students attend preschool Monday through Thursday. Students with Individualized Educational Programs (IEPs) will attend on alternating Fridays.



## Tuition Information

Community peer models will be charged a monthly tuition. Tuition payments will be \$225.00 for the 2017–2018 school year.
