Covid 19 update from Lockwood Schools.

### ***Academics:***

Our third and last enrichment packet will be available for pick up on Friday, April 24th during lunch distribution at the high school. If you prefer to access your enrichment packet online it will be available on google classroom as well. The previous enrichment packets may be turned in on Friday when you come to pick up your new packet. We have partnered with Stockton schools in the past for summer school. If summer school becomes an option with Stockton we will send out information about that as soon as we know something.

We have teachers who will be reaching out to you over the next week and a half. When they reach out to you one question that will be asked is for you to give us some feedback on the academic packets your child/children have received. We will also be asking about the internet and technology capability you have as a family to help us prepare for any potential school closure in the future. I ask that you be willing to speak with our teachers and help us gauge the feelings and needs of our families moving forward. Teachers will only be asking a couple questions and they will only be using the information provided to help us prepare in the future. These conversations will be designed to only take a few minutes of your time. Thank you in advance for any feedback you will be able to provide.

### ***Meals:***

Meals will continue to be provided in the high school circle drive Monday - Friday. We will continue to provide meals through Tuesday, May 12th.

### ***Activities:***

Graduation has been scheduled for Sunday, June 28th at 2:00 PM. We are planning a traditional graduation. Baccalaureate will be Wednesday, June 24th at 7:00 PM. If health regulations will not permit a large gathering at the end of June for a traditional graduation, we will move graduation back to Friday, July 24th at 7:00 PM. Baccalaureate will then be Wednesday, July 22nd at 7:00 PM. Regardless of health regulations graduation will not be pushed back beyond July 24th. If we cannot have a traditional graduation on the 24th an alternate style graduation will take place on the 24th at 7:00 PM.

Prom will be Saturday, July 25th at 8:00 PM. Check in will be at 7:15 and promenade at 7:30.

Any updates about summer activities will be coming at a later date or from the individual coaches/sponsors.

### ***Personal Item Pick up:***

Personal items that are still at school, whether in your locker or school desk, will be able to be picked up the week of May 11th - May 15th.

7th Grade - Tuesday, May 12th from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM  
8th Grade- Wednesday, May 13th from 9:00 AM - 2:00 PM

**Elementary** - Elementary teachers will be contacting each family to set up a parent teacher conference where you can come in and collect your students personal belongings from their classroom.
