**Wesley House:** 411 E. 12<sup>th</sup>, Pittsburg 232-3760 M-F 1-3:30 pm. Can obtain food one time per every 30 days. Some select food M-W-F 1-3:30 pm. You must bring a photo ID of everyone in home over 18, social security card of everyone in the home, proof of address (utility bill or letter from shelter), proof of all income (including food stamps) and fill out a short application. Free meal on Thursdays 5 pm. Children's Summer Food & Sacks for children 2-18 yrs old. Obtain 1 bag of food per child per week. They have Christmas basket sign up and School supplies/clothing voucher sign ups once per year.

**Commodities at Salvation Army:** 307 E. 5<sup>th</sup> St. Pittsburg 231-0415. Ask for application. Bring in verification of income, social security cards for each member of household, verification of residence in Crawford County (mail). Food pick up 3<sup>rd</sup> Thursdays 9 am – 12 pm.

The mission of Wesley House is to provide a safe, welcoming place for individuals and families of Crawford County to seek assistance, advocacy, education and hope for a brighter tomorrow.

The primary program that occurs at Wesley House is the food pantry.

Wesley House has a homeless case manager and we are offering day sheltering. When a homeless person comes in, they can enroll in our homeless day sheltering program which will give them priority use of our shower and laundry facilities. We will feed them breakfast and lunch as well as provide homeless case management which includes identifying and solving the barriers to permanent housing.
