**TUESDAY:** *Tractor day*, wear your favorite tractor brand

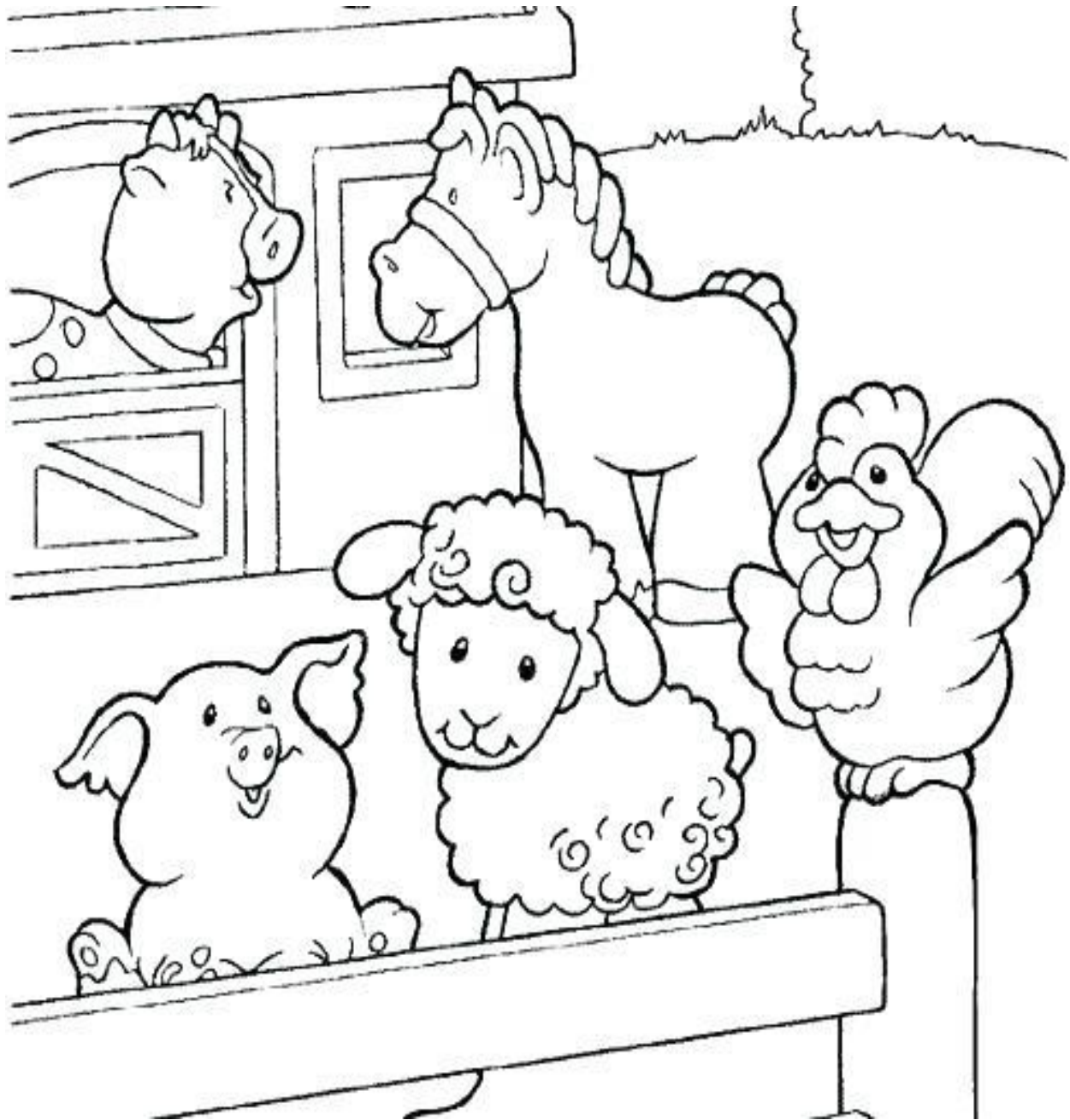
**WEDNESDAY:** *Western Wednesday*, dress up as a cowboy

**FRIDAY:** *FFA Friday*, any FFA apparel, blue and gold, or official dress

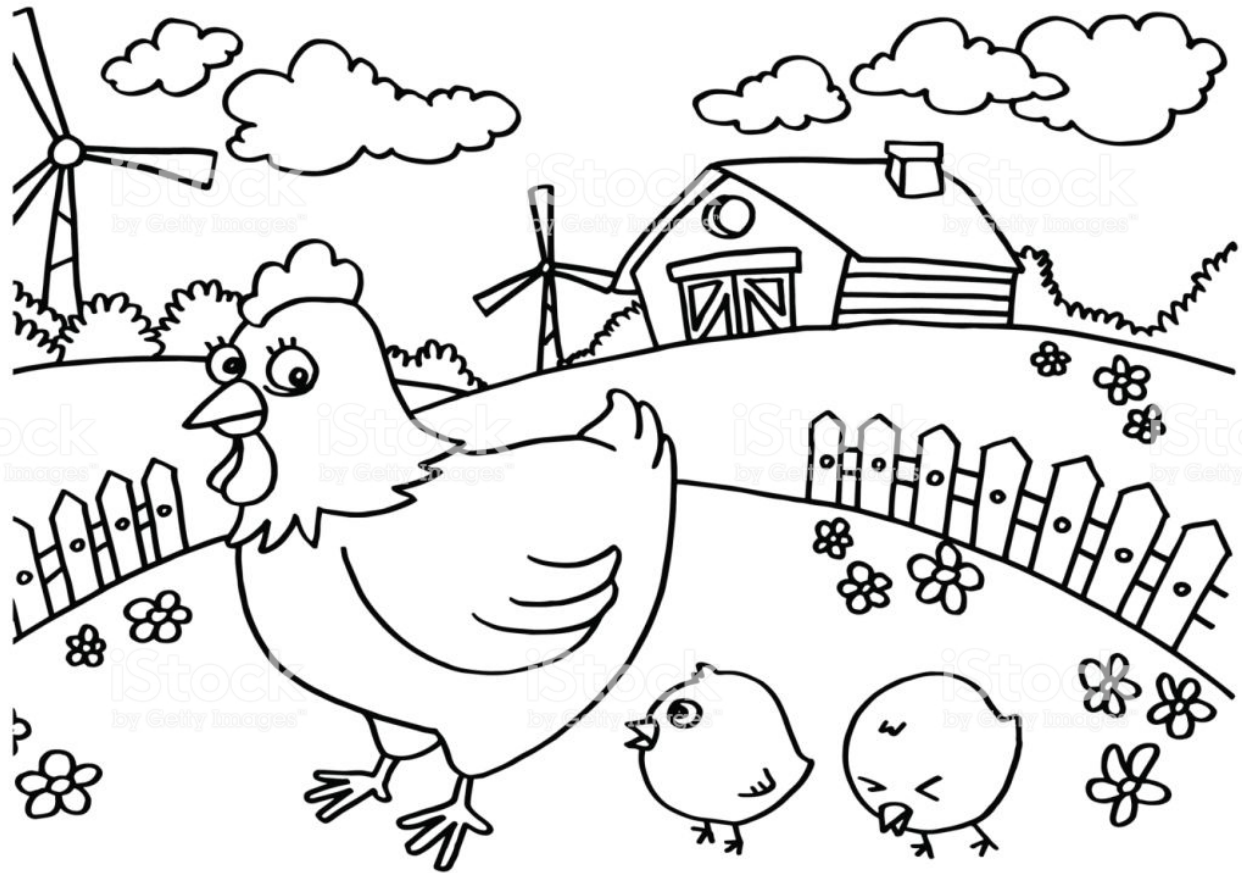
