1. Old Business

- Review of Wellness Policy and Wellness Plan/Tim VanCleave; the rubric has not yet been received; a SHAC subcommittee will be formed in the Spring to work on the Wellness Policy to present at the April SHAC meeting.

- School Foodservice Update/Charla Porter, Stacey Proctor
A foodservice audit is expected from ARAMark in March; desserts were added in February at the Elementary and Primary cafeterias; High School snack bar is open; TDA is encouraging schools to get more feedback from parents and use of surveys; cafeteria managers are more involved and getting to know kids and what they like to eat.
- Campus Safety/Traffic Issues/Abel Sanchez
The only traffic problem is occurring at the Intermediate where cars are going around the buses at dismissal. Abel reported on large pot holes in front of the high school; The City of Robinson was notified and will take care of them.
- Waco/McLennan County Health Dept; AgriLife/Colleen Foleen and Madeline Makovy
Elementary campus is involved in Healthy Campus activities with Madeline and Colleen. Mr. VanCleave will encourage Healthy Campus program with Principals at the next Administrative Team Leader meeting.
- Community Garden/Green Classroom/Brandi Cox/Amanda Marshall
Tim VanCleave reported that the pond bog was repaired by the grounds crew. Amanda Marshall noted that the 2nd grade will participate in the Learn to Grow program w/Maddie.
- Region 12/School Health/Laura Bearden
Epi pens and Narcan are available at all campuses; unable to locate; Ms. Tiechelman retired and Dinah Shaw was rehired in her place; there are 15 AED's districtwide. No COVID cases reported recently.
- Technology/Website/Bryan Fuqua
Bryan reported on a new app for the District replacing Remind; all information will be contained in one location; information to inform parents will be sent out; already started in Jr High sports and band; it will follow kids throughout their activities and school years.
- Safety/David Wrzesinski
