Remote Learning Days-Grading

The State Superintendent's office and Remote Learning Advisory Group declared that schools would transition to Remote Learning Days beginning March 31, 2020.

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) recommends grading procedures that “do no educational harm” to students. In accordance with this directive our grading plan is as follows.

What does this mean for students moving forward?

- Students currently have earned their 3rd quarter grade for the semester.
- Students can improve their grade by engaging and completing the assigned work.
- Teachers will review assigned work and designate a Pass or Incomplete for the 4th quarter. (This graded work can do no harm to the 3rd quarter grade.)
- Assignments will be reviewed to see if improvement occurred. If the assigned work improves, this will be updated and submitted.
- Students that earned an “F” in a class during the 3rd Quarter may be afforded the opportunity to re-submit some work in order to receive a passing grade.

The primary focus is to engage and improve grades of our 3rd quarter students with failures. The secondary focus is to provide enrichment and continued learning opportunities for our students who are passing and demonstrating proficiency.
