Here is your **READING** daily agenda of assignments for this week:

Day 1: "What Do You Do" story - Go for a picture walk (don't read, just go page by page and look at/talk about what is happening in the pictures). **This is a Level E book, which means it is a more difficult level that your child should NOT be expected to read on their own.

- Locate & talk about these Literacy Words (there are 2 pages of picture/words that you should have from the Clarence story:
Title of book, book, author, cover, illustrations/pictures, story, illustrator, read.
- Topic words: bank, buy, earn, home, job, money, work

Read Aloud #1 - Now read the story to/with your child. Talk about: Each of these characters are leaving for work. Can you help me remember the jobs that a character does to earn money? **Identify the Characters in the story and what jobs they do. Circle the characters names in the story. Pick ONE color for all the characters.**

Day 2: **Read Aloud #2** - "What Do You Do" - Review the Literacy words and Topic words from Day 1 (above). **Identify the Settings in the story.** As you read the story aloud with your child today, think and talk about, "I will remember items the characters can buy with their money." **Circle the places they work (settings) in a DIFFERENT color than the characters, in the story.**

Day 3: **Read Aloud #3** this is the Communication Board.  It is the last page of the story. Review all these words with your child **BEFORE** reading today. As an adult reads today, they leave out missing words and it is the child's job to fill in the missing words. **Example,** "Lee's dad works at _____." Where does Lee's dad work? Child says, and can point to on the Communication board, "a factory." **Identify the events (what is happening) in the story. In a DIFFERENT color than Days 1 and 2, circle the topic words in the story today.** Those are listed at the top or on the communication board.

- Do worksheet: Standards Connections WS with title, author, etc.

Day 4: May 4th is a Teacher Remote Planning Day - no assignments

Day 5: Today's focus will be on WH- **Questions: Who, What, Where, When, Why?**
Review Literacy words: answer, detail, question, book, event, retell, character, main idea, and story. ** (Remember, you have a picture/word sheet to help with these!) **Re-read the story with your child, then answer the questions on the worksheets for today.**

- Do Worksheets: Circle the answers on the 5 pages of questions about the story.
