Word List 4 words with -ide: side, ride, wide, slide

- How to practice: Say and spell the words together, using words lists EACH DAY, practicing to "learn" the words. There are not flashcards for these words but you are welcome to make them if that helps. The focus this week is IDENTIFYING RHYMING WORDS.

Day 1: Practice List 3 words. Complete the activities for List 3 words.

- Do 2 Worksheets: Spell and write worksheets for List 3 words. (Letter Trace WS, and Letter Fill-in WS).
- Do 4 Fill-in questions Worksheet: Spelling List 3 has 4 fill in questions, and the last sheet has the choices to cut out and glue in for the answers.

Day 2: Practice List 3 words. Complete the activities for List 3 words.

- Do 4 Word study questions Worksheet: Spelling List 3 has 4 word study questions, and the last sheet has the choices to cut out and glue in for the answers.
- -ose Word Families practice Board: there is a 3-page practice board for the -ose words. 1st page is the board; 2nd page is the beginning sounds, pic/words, and words to CUT OUT and use to practice the rhyming words on page 1 board. Page 3 is a 4 square story to cut out and read with the rhyming -ose words.

Day 3: Practice List 4 words. Complete the activities for List 4 words.

- Do 2 Worksheets: Spell and write worksheets for List 4 words. (Letter Trace WS, and Letter Fill-in WS).
- Do 4 Fill-in questions Worksheet: Spelling List 4 has 4 fill in questions, and the last sheet has the choices to cut out and glue in for the answers.

Day 5: Practice List 4 words. Complete the activities for List 4 words.

- Do 4 Word study questions Worksheet: Spelling List 4 has 4 word study questions, and the last sheet has the choices to cut out and glue in for the answers.
- -ide Word Families practice Board: there is a 3-page practice board for the -ide words. 1st page is the board; 2nd page is the beginning sounds, pic/words, and words to CUT OUT & use to practice the rhyming words on page 1 board. Page 3 is a 4 square story to cut out and read with the rhyming -ide words.
