

Washington County FFA Plant Sale Flyer

Saturday, May 2nd 9:00am – 1:00pm
(or longer if needed)

The Washington County FFA will be hosting our Plant Sale on Saturday, May 2nd from 9am until at least 2pm. This will be much different this year than normal, as you can imagine.

Not to be rude, but due to State and Federal Laws currently in place for COVID 19, these guidelines WILL BE FOLLOWED or we will have to end the sale.

We will have all of the plants in the parking lot on the East side of the greenhouse, please do not park in that parking lot at all. Park in the North Parking lot, up by the high school and Concession Stand Entrance to the Track/Bleachers.

The flow of the sale will be from North to South. Pay at the South East Exit and pile your plants for pick up. Drive your car to the South east corner of the parking lot for pickup.

Enter the plant isles from the North Only. You will have to be permitted to enter so that we limit the number of shoppers in the plant areas at all times.

You must stay greater than 6 feet apart. We would prefer if you followed the state health requirements and wore a mask and gloves. NO STUDENTS are allowed to participate. No entry allowed into any/all school buildings

After you have selected your plants, you will pay at the South End Payment Station. There will be an area for Pick-up at the South East Corner of the parking lot so when you leave, you are driving south toward College street. Signs will be posted to direct traffic/pick up areas.

Because of the sale situation and due to the nature of trying to determine who goes first, there will be no decision or selection of who goes through this and when. We will have a number for you to pick up as you drive in to the North Parking Lot. You will not be permitted to enter the Sale Area without a Number. You are to stay in your vehicle until your Number is announced. Only one person may enter per Number assigned. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate extras this year.

As a result, the earlier you arrive, the longer you will probably have to wait. I do apologize in advance, but this is the only fair way that I can see, and I completely want to be fair to everyone involved.

We will probably only have three to five people volunteering as helpers for this sale, so realize you will have to load most of your items yourself.

Thank you for your understanding, hopefully we will see you on Saturday, May 2nd!
