Agricultural Education/FFA:

Physical Education:

Athletic shoes, shorts/sweats, and t-shirt (no specifications on style/brand) Fees are charged for bowling unit (\$10) and golf unit (\$5)-money can be paid during the unit, not ahead of time. Students must have a pair of clean tennis shoes for PE inside and a different pair for PE outside. Students are expected to dress out.

Science:
