Dear Parents/Guardians,

This letter is to inform you that an individual in your child's class has tested positive for COVID-19 and your child may have been exposed.

## **ACTIONS TO TAKE:**

We encourage you to watch for any symptoms of COVID-19 in your child for the next 10 days, through 2/5. If your child develops any symptoms of COVID-19, please notify Mrs. Berrouet, contact your child's doctor for evaluation and/or testing, and keep your child home from school, childcare, and activities.

Symptoms could include any of the following:

- Fever of 100.4°F / 38°C or higher
- New or worsening cough
- Shortness of breath/difficulty breathing
- Chills
- Fatigue
- Muscle pain or body aches

- New taste or smell disorder
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Headache

Students and staff, regardless of vaccination status, who are identified as \*close contacts or who may have been exposed, may continue to attend school as long as they remain symptom free and wear a mask while at school for 10 days following exposure. Testing is strongly encouraged 5 days after the potential exposure date.

If your child tests positive for COVID-19 test result, even if asymptomatic, please keep your child home from school, activities, camp and childcare for at least 5 days and notify the school nurse, Mrs. Berrouet at (609) 835-8960 ext. 6003. Please feel free to contact us with any questions.

\*Close contact: A close contact is someone who was exposed to a person with COVID-19 infection. A close contact is generally defined as someone who was within 6 feet of a COVID-19 case for 15 cumulative minutes or more over a 24-hour period of time during the case's infectious period.
